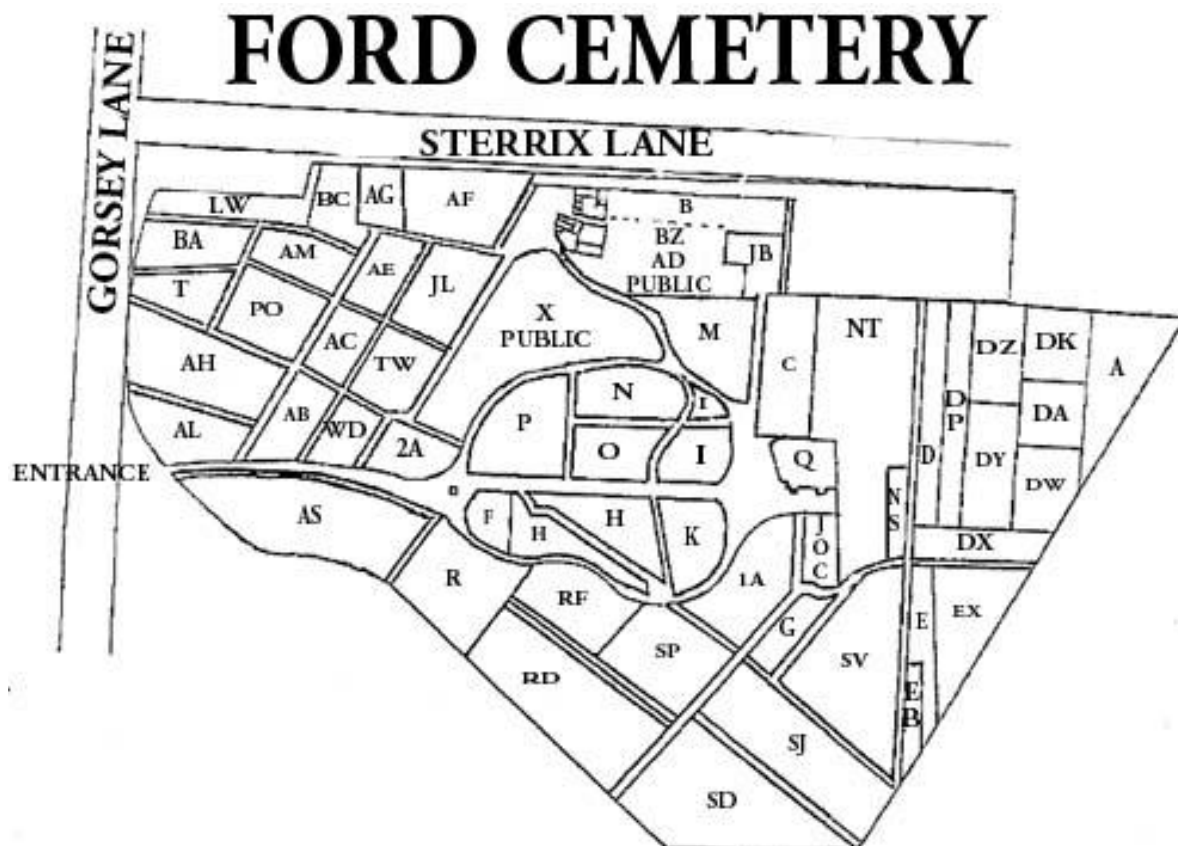

Public Grave SV1197 contains the remains of 13 persons who were interred in October & November 1883. The grave was re-opened in December 1930 and another 5 were interred. In January 1931, 6 more were interred, making a total of 24 poor Catholics all interred in one grave. The only thing they had in common was they were from poor working class families that could not afford the extra cost of Private Grave. There are no markers on any Public Grave at Ford Cemetery. SV Section is a large triangular field that contains the remains of many thousands of persons. There are around 3639 Public Graves in SV Section, they contain on average 20 persons, so that's 20 X 3639 = 72,780.
