The above-named person filed an application to become naturalized, the original of which is one of about 9,000 similar records on file in Room No. 815, Hall of Records, 31 Chambers St., Manhattan. This office has been informed that there is no index for these records in the Hall of Records. The records appear to have been filed away there in chronological order. Neither this record nor any of the others with which it is filed contains an order of admission or any notation or memo from which it may be inferred that this person or any of the others was admitted to citizenship; furthermore, at least one case was found in which the declaration of intention was detached from the file and according to notation was returned to the applicant.

The fact that the records mentioned herein were not filed with and made a part of the records of persons who were naturalized in the Supreme Court New York County; that they were separated from such records; that they are devoid of an order of admission in every instance; that they apparently were never indexed, and from other facts and circumstances, it appears clear that these applications were either abandoned by the respective applicants or they were dismissed or denied by the court. At all events, it seems clear that none of these persons was admitted to citizenship on the basis of the instant proceeding.
