### ARRESTED FOR THEFT.

#### **Stephen Kunelyos Accused of Taking Condos's Valuables.**

Stephen Kunelyos, a Greek, who has been wanted by the local police since October 6 on a charge of stealing a watch and chain and two diamond rings from Thomas Condos, who owns a candy store at No. 599 Main street, was arrested in New York last night and will be brought to this city today by Detective Sergeant Butler. Kunelyos was employed by Condos at the time of the alleged theft and on October 6 he dressed up in his best clothes, saying he was going out to have his picture taken. Instead of returning to his work in due time, however, Kunelyos left the city and it was not long before Condos discovered that his watch and chain and the rings had also disappeared.
