

IN THE CRIMINAL COURT.

Mistrial Entered in Case Against Nick Condos.

In the criminal district court yesterday Nick Condos was tried on the charge of unlawfully carrying a dirk, but the jury was unable to reach a verdict, Judge Campbell after allowing the jury to deliberate over the case, discharged them and entered a mistrial.

Nick Condos, carrying a dirk; mistrial. Tom Lichtenstine, unlawfully carrying pistol, passed to April 8.

John Taylor, unlawfully carrying pistol; passed to April 5.

Ben Lauderdale, robbery by assault; passed to April \
