

**INSOLVENCY ADMITTED.**

**Answer Filed by Alexander and Condos in Federal Court.**

An answer admitting insolvency was filed yesterday in the Federal court in the bankruptcy proceedings brought several days ago against the firm of Alexander & Condos, proprietors of Rector's cafe, at 410 Main street. The answer was signed by Thomas Condos and contains a prayer for the appointment of a trustee to take charge of the restaurant immediately.

The liabilities listed in the answer are as follows: Jim Condos, \$2500; the Co-Operative Produce company, \$94.45; G. F. Thrift, \$800; Collins Brothers, \$150; G. F. D. Cleveland & Sons, \$125; Gus Manos, \$400.

The assets consist of the place of business at 410 Main street, valued at \$5000, and \$33 in cash.
