

Old Greek Ceremony Used For Engagement

The father of the bride-to-be, Nicholas Karukas, stood before a sacred ikon constructed more than seventy-five years ago, and crossed the engagement rings and placed them on the ikon opposite to where they should properly be. Then the father of the prospective groom, Thomas Condos, took up the rings and recrossing them, placed them properly before the young couple, completing the ancient Greek engagement ceremony. An orchestra that played was composed entirely of members of the bride's family.
