Josiah W. Levy, lawyer for Thomas Condos, said yesterday that the liabilities of his client were about \$7,000.

At a meeting of the creditors of Condos on Monday it was estimated that the liabilities were about \$4,000. Mr. Levy said that the assets were about \$2,700. Condos at one time had a confectionery store on Asylum street. He sold it out a few months ago and lately he has been running a confectionery store at No. 500 Main street.
