That he has resided within the United States for more than five years last past and in the State of New Hamp shire for more than one year last past; and that during his said residence in the United States he has behaved as a man of good moral character, attached to the principles of the Constitution of the United States, and well disposed to the good order and happiness of the same,

That he has never borne any hereditary title, or been of any of the orders of nobility.
