each one share and the remaining one fifth
or share I give to the children of my de-
ceased son George J. Jerks to be equally
divided among them.

Third. I hereby authorize and empower my
executors hereinafter named to sell and
dispose of all my real estate either at
public or private sale for the best price
that can be obtained therefor at any time
that may be suitable to them and apply
the proceeds of the same to the payment
of the aforesaid legacies.

Lastly, I hereby nominate and appoint my
sons Austin Jerks and Moses Jerks the
Executors of this my last Will and Testa-
ment.
