Rec., 1850-60 Census Rye and Mamaroneck, Greenwood-Union Cem. Rec.); Matthew, b. 14 Apr. 1791 (ERB 271); William, b. 14 Oct. 1793 (ERB 314), d. 27 Apr. 1832, m. Charlotte, b. c.1796, d. 24 Aug. 1876, dau. of James Angevine (Westchester Co. Wills 31:237), res. N.Y.C., bur. Ref. Dutch Church yard, Unionville (Hawthorne), had Phoebe⁶ b. c.1818, William H. b. c.1824, probably others (1850-60 Census, N.Y.C. Ward 9, Unionville Cem. Rec.); and James Van Wart, b. 9 Apr. 1795 (ERB 387).
- 30 ii. Marytie, bap. 16 Apr. 1771, deceased by 1809 (Rec. 60:151); m. William, b. 21 Nov. 1764 (TB1855), d. 27 July 1849 ae. 84-8, bur. Hawthorne churchyard, son of William and Catherine (See) Yerks (Rec. 114:159, #16). Eight children b. at Philipsburgh, five mentioned in their grandfather Foshay's will. DVT wrote, "This William was known as 'Brook' William Yerks to distinguish him from another William Yerks. His house was situated very near the Saw Mill River, which stream he crossed by bridge to get to the highway. His farm was opposite the old iron mine in the town of Mount Pleasant" (Yerks Gen.).
- 31 iii. Jannitie, bap. 17 Apr. 1773, d. 23 July 1856, ae. 83-4-9, bur. Hawthorne churchyard; m. James, b. 20 Sept. 1773 (DVT), d. 21 Dec. 1855, ae. 82-3-1, bur. Hawthorne churchyard, son of Jacobus and Christina (Boice) Van Wart. Nine children bap. at Philipsburgh, five mentioned in grandfather Foshay's will.
- 32 iv. William, bap. 17 June 1775, d. 4 Jan. 1811, ae. 35-7-22, bur. Sleepy Hollow churchyard (g.s. 19); m. 4 Jan. 1803 in the White Plains Methodist Church, Phebe Downing (DVT); no issue. His will, dated 27 Nov. 1810, probated 8 Jan. 1811, mentions wife, three brothers, and sisters Jane Van Wart, Anna Vincent and Elizabeth Hall (Westchester Co. Wills E:113).
- 33 v. Abraham, bap. 27 Apr. 1777; m. Catherine Jane (ERB 48), b. 19 Feb. 1783, dau. of Uytendale and Sarah (Seaman) Allaire. Children: possibly three sons under 10, two daughters under 10, one daughter 10 and under 16 (1810 Census, Westchester Co., p. 229). A daughter Lucinda⁵, b. 1812, d. 27 May 1887, ae. 75, bur. Old Huguenot Burying Ground, New Rochelle (New Rochelle Chapter, D.A.R., *New Rochelle Tombstone Inscriptions*, 1941, p. 15). Abraham and his wife were still living in 1855 in N.Y.C. (1855 State Census, 15th Ward).
- 34 vi. Antie, b. 24 Aug. 1779 (DVT), bap. 30 May 1784, d. 10 July 1823 (DVT); m. John, b. 1761, d. 27 Mar. 1830, ae. 69, bur. Hawthorne churchyard, son of Charles Vincent. Children: Nancy Ann, b. 27 June 1794, m. John Van Tassel, b. 1793; Harriet, m. William, son of Thaddeus Avery; John Foshay; Andrew; and James Odell (DVT). Three children mentioned in grandfather Foshay's will.
- 35 vii. Rebecca, b. 11 Sept. 1781 (Bible rec.), bap. 30 May 1784; d.y.
- 36 viii. Merriam, b. 19 Apr., bap. 30 May 1784; d.y.
- 37 ix. Elizabeth, bap. 16 Nov. 1786 (ERB 91; Bible record date of birth and place of baptism are incorrect); m. George Kniffen, son of Edward Hall; res. Herkimer Co., N.Y. (DVT). She d. 7 Sept. 1870, bur. Van Etten Cem., place not given (Foshay-Van Wart MS. by Dr. Amos Canfield, MS. Coll. NYGBS). One son, Edward, b. 1805, m. 1832 Susan Westbrook, b. 1811 (DVT).
- 38 x. Isaac, b. 5 Nov. 1789, d. 5 June 1860, ae. 72-2; m. c.1813 Mary, b. 1793, d. 1 May 1867, ae. 74, dau. of Dr. William and Elizabeth (Goodwin or Godwin) Adams; both bur. Hawthorne churchyard. She is mentioned in her father's will (Westchester Co. Wills K:301). Children: Eliza Jane, b. c.1815 (1850 Census, Westchester Co., N.Y., Vol. 1, Mount Pleasant, transcribed by Natalie M. Seth); Susan Antoinette, b. 23 Mar. 1816 (ERB 1095); Esthalinda, b. 1818, m. John Van Tassel; Mariette,
