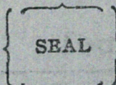

TO CITY AND TOWN CLERKS

Domestic relations law—Section 19 . . . On or before the fifteenth day of each month the said town and city clerk . . . shall file in the office of the county clerk of the county in which said town or city is situated, a copy . . . of each . . . license and certificate, which have been filed or made before him during the preceding month . . .
