GIRL TRIPLETS BORN, 1 DIES

Two Others Have Good Chance to Survive, Hospital Reports

One of the girl triplets born early yesterday morning in Williamsburg Maternity Hospital to Mr. and Mrs. George Yerks of 118 McKinley Avenue, Brooklyn, died shortly after 10 o'clock last night. The two other babies are doing well and have better than an even chance to survive, officials at the hospital said. The mother, they declared, is "doing nicely."

The babies, two weighing one pound and the third a pound and a half, were born at 3:40, 3:50 and 4 A. M. It was the second that succumbed. They were placed in incubators. Mr. Yerks is a maintenance helper on the B. M. T. The couple have no other children.
