all the rest Residue and remainder
of my property I give devise and
bequeath as follows. One fifth part
thereof to my Sister Peninna Hunter
One fifth part thereof to my Sister Catherine
Onderdonk. One fifth part thereof to
my Sister Ann Grahame. ——————
One fifth part thereof to the three (3) children
of my deceased Sister Lucinda Clark
equally divided between them. Slave and
Slave alike. One fifth part thereof to the
children of my deceased Sister Jemimah
Bailey to be equally divided between them
Slave and Slave alike.

Loitly I do nominate and appoint
Moses W. Taylor and
John E. Bailey my Executors of this
my last will and testament. In witness
